


License Capacity in Family Child Care Homes


License Capacity for six (6) children.

One provider may care for:

Four (4) infants (less than 24 months) ONLY.



Six (6) children, with no more than three (3) infants (less than 24 months).



License Capacity for eight (8) children.


One provider may care for:

Eight (8) children, with no more than two (2) infants (less than 24 months), and six (6) older children, when one child is at least six years of age and one child is enrolled in and attending kindergarten or elementary school.




License Capacity for twelve (12) children. One provider and one assistant may care for:

Twelve (12) children, with no more than four (4) infants (less than 24 months old) and eight (8) older children.



License Capacity for fourteen (14) children. One provider and one assistant may care for:

Fourteen (14) children, with no more than three (3) infants (less than 24 months old) and when one child is at least six years of age and one child is enrolled in and attending kindergarten or elementary school.



*Any children that reside in the provider's home, under the age of 10 needs to be included in total capacity.
